HOSTING GUIDELINES

Thank you for your interest in becoming a host for this remarkable exhibit. Please read the guidelines below and contact us if you have any questions. If you would like to apply to host The Eyes of Freedom Memorial, please fill out an Application on the following pages and send it to us as instructed.

- 1. **Security** The Memorial requires a secure environment, not only to honor the memory of our heroes, but also to ensure it is safe from vandalism and theft. Our staff needs to know your surveillance plans.
- 2. <u>Space Requirements</u> There are 8 panels each measuring 6' wide x 9' tall x 4' deep. In order to have at least 3 feet between and around each panel, the Memorial needs to be displayed in spaces with a minimum of 40' x 40' or 20' x 60' elongated. Space is also required for our 3 interactive kiosks, each 96" tall, 4'deep, two at 70" wide, and one at 52" wide. Silent Battle, our bronze sculpture, sits on a 5' diameter octagonal metal base and is about 4' tall. Please speak with our staff for guidance. Also, a place is needed to display the 34' Eyes of Freedom trailer.
- 3. <u>Venue Options</u> These include college student unions, state capitol buildings, local government buildings, county fairgrounds, art galleries, and High School gymnasiums, among many others.
- 4. <u>Lighting</u> If your building/enclosure is not equipped with proper lighting, we ask that you provide extra lighting for these special paintings. Lighting is required for evening viewing hours.
- 5. <u>Admittance Fees</u> There is no fee for the public to see this Memorial at your event. If your event charges admission, there will be no additional charge to view The Eyes of Freedom display.
- 6. <u>Volunteers</u> We highly recommend the host provide docent volunteers to assist our staff in crewing the Memorial. A minimum of TEN to TWELVE volunteers is required to set up and take down the Memorial. Our staff is there to provide direction to them for assembling and disassembling the exhibit. Each volunteer needs to be able to carry 50 pounds and arrive promptly at designated times. **Please note:** the Memorial depends on your volunteers and cannot be offloaded without appropriate muscle power. If volunteers are not provided during take down after the event, a \$1500 fee will be assessed.
- 7. **Entrance** If no loading dock exists at your venue, double doors leading to the display must have dividers removed.
- 8. <u>Signage</u> Identifying signs provided by The Eyes of Freedom must be prominently displayed.
- 9. <u>Donations</u> Please direct individual donors to our website (www.EyesOfFreedom.org) or provide our Eyes of Freedom address: 2561 Jade Court, Grove City, OH 43123. We are a 5103c organization and all donations are tax deductible. *You agree, by hosting us at your event, that we can openly solicit donations*. Additionally, Eyes of Freedom merchandise is available for purchase during all display hours.
- 10. <u>Cost</u> The host agrees to pay for displaying The Eyes of Freedom Memorial according to the Contract to be signed by both the host and The Eyes of Freedom staff.
